Campbell's Creek Trail Tour

This trail crosses flood plains covered with native vegetation. It runs besides Barkers Creek until the junction with Forest Creek and thereafter the combined flow is known as Campbell's Creek. This disability accessible tour has been organised in partnership with MASDAG; an independent advocate of systemic change that supports equitable social participation for Mount Alexander Shire residents. It will end with a Castlemaine Historical Society tour of Goldsmith Street.
